Am I eligible?

The Grant a Guitar scholarship is available to any fulltime student currently enrolled in one of the participating Schools in the month of April 2018.

This year's participating high schools are Chagrin Falls High School, Kenston High School, Orange High School, Solon High School, and Aurora High School.

This year's participating middle schools are Chagrin Falls Middle School, Kenston Middle School, Ballard Brady Middle School, Solon Middle School, Orchard Middle School and Harmon Middle School.

How do I apply?

Submit an original essay (no longer than 500 words) on this year's theme: **How does music act as a peacemaker in your life?**
